Motion made and amended by Karl Rimkus that once the action plans are developed by the committees, that they be considered by the Board for inclusion into the Trust's Strategic Plan and to develop action plans for short- and long-term goals identified in the strategic planning today, and to ratify the goals expressed today as Financial Sustainability, Organizational Development, Exceptional Service, and Risk Management; seconded by Rene Peña.
